### DIRECTIONS:

**Southbound** on I-5 take **EXIT 95** (Maytown), go **WEST** towards the Farmboy Restaurant. Turn **SOUTH** (Left) on to **CASE ROAD** for about 5 miles to the parking area on the **RIGHT**.

**Northbound** on I-5 take **EXIT 88B**. Crossover the freeway to the traffic light, turn **RIGHT**. Stay **RIGHT** until you come to a stop sign; turn **LEFT** (Elderberry St.). Stay on Elderberry St. until you come to a stop sign and turn **RIGHT** onto 183rd. Stay on 183rd until you come to Case Rd., turn **LEFT** onto Case Rd. for about 1 mile. The parking area is on the **LEFT**
