## DIRECTIONS:

From Morton WA - Head north on State Route 7 for 28.7 miles, going through Elbe, then turn left onto Mashel Prairie Road. Parking is 6 miles on the right under the power lines.

From north or southbound I-5 - Take Hwy512 exit towards Puyallup then take the exit for State Route 7 and follow it to Mashel Prairie Road and turn right. Parking is .6 miles on the right under the power lines.
