Long Course | 10 objectives | 1-6th place

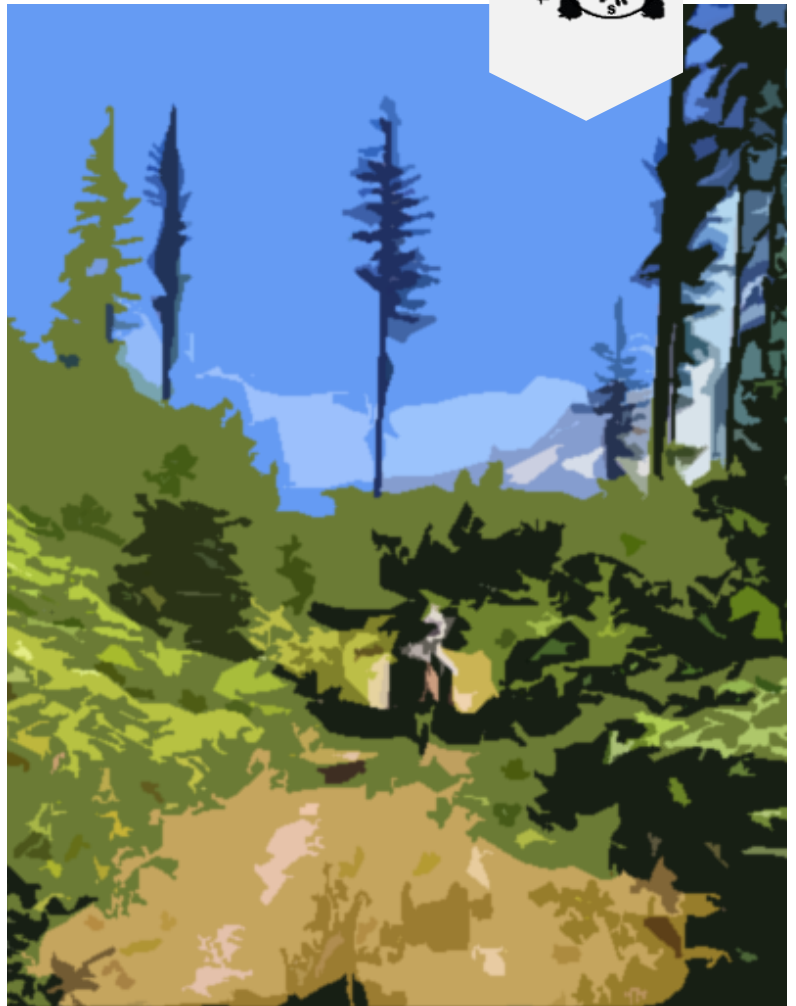
Short Course | 5 objectives | 1-3rd place
