
(Riders / Teams will be timed out at 5 minute intervals)

All riders welcome: Bring your own horse, feed, water, and lunch. Don't forget your discover pass and map compass. A map of the course will be provided at the start line. If you're new and need a map compass, there will be a limited supply of map compasses to borrow or purchase from the ride managers. If you would like a mentor, please contact one of the ride managers (info above) or add a comment on WACMO Facebook group.

Camping available w/ highline poles, pit toilets, manure bins & creek water nearby for horses.

Please remember to clean up hay and manure.

<u>DIRECTIONS FROM I-5:</u> Take the <u>SEDRO WOOLLEY / COOK RD EXIT 232</u>, go <u>EAST 4.2 MILES</u>. There will be 2 traffic circles very close together, then around a curve in the main road and a 3<sup>rd</sup> traffic circle. The signs are clear so follow them to get onto and stay on <u>HIGHWAY 20 EAST</u>. Continue <u>EAST</u> on <u>HWY 20</u> for approximately <u>11.4 MILES</u>. Turn <u>LEFT</u> at the <u>FIRE STATION</u> onto <u>CABIN CREEK RD</u>, then <u>RIGHT</u> onto <u>HAMILTON CEMETERY RD</u>, <u>LEFT</u> onto <u>MEDFORD RD</u>, go about <u>1.0 MILE</u> and you'll come to the <u>LES HILDE</u> trailhead and camping area. There will be CMO directional plates to follow off of HWY 20.
