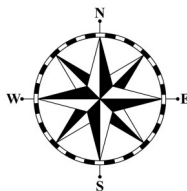

LONG COURSE, 10 OBJECTIVES
W/ RIBBONS 1ST–6TH
(Approx 12-14 miles, 6 hr. time limit)

SHORT COURSE, 5 OBJECTIVES
W/ RIBBONS 1ST–3RD
(Approx 7-9 miles, 6 hr. time limit)

8:00 a.m. On-site Registration (Cash or Check payments only)

9:00 a.m. Pre-ride compass and map reading instructions

(For anyone who would like an introduction or refresher)

9:30 a.m. Mandatory Ride Meeting and Position Draw

10:00 a.m. 1st Rider / Team out (Team / Group size, 6 riders max)

(Riders / Teams will be timed out at 5 minute intervals)

Camping available w/ highline poles, pit toilets, manure bins & creek water nearby for horses.
Please remember to clean up hay and manure.

DIRECTIONS FROM I-5: Take the **SEDRO WOOLLEY / COOK RD EXIT 232**, go **EAST 4.2 MILES**. There will be 2 traffic circles very close together, then around a curve in the main road and a 3rd traffic circle. The signs are clear so follow them to get onto and stay on **HIGHWAY 20 EAST**. Continue **EAST** on **HWY 20** for approximately **11.4 MILES**. Turn **LEFT** at the **FIRE STATION** onto **CABIN CREEK RD**, then **RIGHT** onto **HAMILTON CEMETERY RD**, **LEFT** onto **MEDFORD RD**, go about **1.0 MILE** and you'll come to the **LES HILDE** trailhead and camping area. There will be CMO directional plates to follow off of HWY 20.
