FROM I-5 SOUTH- Take **EXIT 88** toward Tenino/ Rochester/Oakville. At the end of the exit turn **EAST** onto Old Hwy. 99 SW towards Tenino. In approx. 8 miles take a **SLIGHT LEFT** onto WA-507/Wichman St. Follow WA-507 through Tenino.

FROM I-5 NORTH- Take **EXIT 101** & take **LEFT** onto Tumwater Blvd. Take **RIGHT** onto Old HWY 99 to Tenino approx. 9.8 miles. Take **LEFT** onto WA-507/Sussex Ave. **BOTH I-5S & I-5N WILL THEN**: Turn **LEFT** onto Old Military Rd. SE then take the first **LEFT** onto Vantine Road. M.T. Pockets Ranch is about 4/10 of a mile on the **LEFT**. NOTE: If coming from Tumwater there is a 12'6" overpass.
