Competitive Mounted Orienteering (C.M.O.)

This is a timed event using map & compass to find hidden objectives spread out over several miles of beautiful, scenic countryside.

All Riders WELCOME: *Bring your own horse, compass, feed, water, and lunch!*

Pre-ride compass instruction for those who would like help.

Daily entry fees:

Annual NACMO members \$20.00, junior members \$10.00.

Non-members: \$25.00 each (Includes insurance).

- Registration starts at 8:00 am
- Ride Meeting and draw 9:30 am
- First Rider/Team out @ 10:00 am
- Team size is 6 riders maximum

CMO IS A TIMED EVENT WHERE EITHER INDIVIDUALS OR TEAMS ON HORSEBACK USE A COMPASS AND MAP (PROVIDED) TO FIND OBJECTIVES (HIDDEN PLATES).

LONG COURSE CONSISTS OF 10 OBJECTIVES W/ RIBBONS THRU 6TH PLACE

SHORT COURSE CONSISTS OF 5 OBJECTIVES W/ RIBBONS THRU 3RD PLACE

DIRECTIONS:

From the West/South: From I-5 or Hwy 167 take Hwy 18 East. Take exit for WA-516 East / SE 272nd St Covington. Turn right (East) on Hwy 516 (Kent-Kangley). In 4.7 mi. you will come to the intersection of Maple Valley Hwy 169 and Kent-Kangley Road / Hwy 516 (Four Corners). Continue East on Kent-Kangley Road and take the first left onto SE Summit Landsburg Road. Approximately a mile up the road you will park on the wide shoulder on the North (left) side of the road.

From the North/East: From I-90 or Hwy 202/203 take Hwy 18 West. Take exit for Hobart / Issaquah and turn left (South) onto Issaquah Hobart Rd SE. In 0.3 mi. the road name changes to 276th Ave SE and in 3.4 mi. the road name changes to Landsburg Rd SE. Continue another 1.0 mi. Immediately after crossing the Cedar River, bear right onto SE 253rd St. Continue straight onto SE Summit-Landsburg Rd - 1.3 mi. Parking is along the North (right) side of SE Summit Landsburg Road where the shoulder widens west of Summit Trail Middle School.
