Competitive Mounted Orienteering is a timed event using map & compass to find hidden objectives, on HORSEBACK, spread out over several miles of beautiful and scenic countryside.

## All Riders WELCOME:

Bring your own horse, feed, water, and provisions!

Located along the middle fork of the Teanaway River, the camp offers campsites, picnic tables, and pit toilet. Stock water available a short walk away at the river only. Highline stock from trees or bring your own corral panels. Campfires allowed with burn regulations permitting.

### Directions:

Start at I-90 exit 85 (Cle Elum). Go east on SR-970 for 6.9 miles. Turn left on Teanaway Road. Go 7.3 miles. Turn left on West Fork Teanaway Road for .6 miles. Turn right on Middle Fork Teanaway Road. Go 3.9 miles (last mile will be unpaved). Turn right into Indian Camp horse campground.
